Memorandum of Understanding
between
the Vacaville Teachers Association (VTA)
and the
Vacaville Unified School District (VUSD)

The following language goes into effect June 1, 2021 and sunsets August 20, 2021.

- 3.9 Summer School/Super Saturday School
- 3.9.1 Unit members working Summer School/Super Saturday School shall be paid at the rate delineated on Appendix A, Section K for four (4) hours of instructional time. The duty day shall not exceed four and one-half hours (4.5) hours.
- 3.9.1.1 The Summer School schedule may be five (5) hours per day of instructional time, with at least one (1) twenty (20) minute break during the instructional day, and up to thirtyfive (35) minutes of preparation time each day. The pay per day for five-hour Summer School shall be proportional for the instructional minutes in Article 3.9.1 (i.e. \$206.25 for 5 hours is proportional to \$165 for 4 hours).
- 3.9.2 For Summer School, elementary class size shall average twenty (20) students with a cap of twenty-two (22) students, within five (5) instructional days.
- 3.9.3 For Summer School, secondary class size shall average thirty (30) students with a cap of thirty-six (36) students, within five (5) instructional days.

Appendix A, Section K: Summer School (all programs): \$200.00 per day

For unit members that provide enrichment activities and learning hub support beyond the summer school duty day, the pay would be forty-five dollars (\$45.00) per hour.

Unit members who teach in the Extended School Year (ESY) Program shall receive an additional one-time, two-hundred-fifty dollars (\$250) stipend for the full program (this stipend may be prorated for split assignments).

Each site housing a summer school program shall have a Teacher-in-Charge and/or a site administrator. The Teacher-in-Charge shall be paid two-hundred dollars (\$200.00) per day with a four-and-a-half (4.5) hour duty day and forty-five dollars (\$45) per hour for additional supervision as needed.
