The VTA/CTA/NEA 21-22 Bargaining Update Issue #6 March 30, 2022

VTA and VUSD met for 3 hours on March 30, 2022.

We revisited the following topics:

Calendar:

We are close to a tentative agreement on 22-23 and 23-24 calendars, including an elementary report card/progress report committee and a late start day on the day after winter break.

<u>Hiring Ratios for Counselors and Psychologists:</u>

We discussed the current ratios for both positions. We need to cost out different ratio options and how to deal with compensation for additional work.

VUSD brought up the following topics/articles to discuss in the future:

- 10.5: adding two levels to the evaluation forms (1-5 instead of 1-3)
- 9.4.3: adding in provisions for sub emergency days in co-teaching model
- 7.5.1: add Elementary ELD teachers to the itinerant job list
- -Evaluation procedures for Adult Education
- 4.1.4.1: District would like to increased 3 preps to 4 preps without consent of the unit member

VTA brought up the following topics/articles to discuss in the future:

- -4.2 Site Meetings (including Wednesday Collaboration time)
- -9.2, 9.3, new article: class sizes for elementary, secondary and RSP/SDC

-4.1.4 and 4.1.5: elementary and secondary prep time

VUSD requested to extend the bargaining scope to include 22-23 for wages and health benefits. VTA will need to discuss this idea with its Executive Board on 4/5 and survey before agreeing to an extension.
