

Memorandum of Understanding Between the Vacaville Unified School District and the Vacaville Teachers Association

District-Declared Sub Emergencies MOU

The following provisions shall go into effect on July 1, 2024 and shall be incorporated into the next collective bargaining agreement upon ratification.

4.11 District-Declared Substitute Emergencies

A District-Declared Substitute Emergency shall be declared when there are insufficient substitutes available to cover all leave requests. When a District-Declared Substitute Emergency is declared, all unit members shall be notified by email from Human Resources. The following chart shows the procedures and the order to be followed during a District-Declared Substitute Emergency.

- 4.11.1 "Available" certificated unit members are those not actively serving students, either through the nature of their position or because they have a preparation period at the time a substitute is needed.
- 4.11.2 Unit members shall have access to a rotation schedule prior to being directed to substitute during their available time.
- 4.11.3 Any unit member who does not volunteer at the step deemed Voluntary shall decline without penalty.
- 4.11.4 The following chart shows the procedures and the order to be followed during a District-Declared Substitute Emergency:
